Captured in a Tay Ninh bunker complex in December, 1969, and now mounted in a frame 36" W x 24" H. #6111

### 2. Lot of (2) Pith Helmets

The first is a green N.V.C. decorated and ID'd inside on the underside of the brim including an airplane flying over mountains in Tay-Ninh. The second is a white civil helmet having Vietnamese manufacturer's label inside. #6111

### 3. NVA Uniform Grouping

NVA pith helmet, NVA brown shirt with green buttons, Chi Com AK-47 ammo vest, and a Chi Com pistol belt having a two-piece buckle with the star.

### 4. Viet Cong Uniform Grouping

including a black cotton three pocket shirt, (2) pair of black pj's, one pair of shorts, 1 pair of Ho Chi Minh "tire" sandals, and a VC belt having the rolled buckle.

### 5. Viet Cong Uniform Grouping
